



EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR MESSAGE

My Dear Friends,

I am excited to share with you our 2021 accomplishments. Despite the pandemic continuing to impact our lives and our clients in so many ways, we were able to continue to offer value-added programs and services.

All programs other than suiting were held virtually. We held three sessions of our "Road to Success" Job Readiness Program and 26 women graduated from the program, 15 of whom found gainful employment within 30 days of completing the program. We held 11 sessions of our Professional Women's Group, covering topics such as "Setting Goals for the New Year"; 'Emotional Intelligence"; "How to Talk Like a Boss"; and "Conversations on Leadership." We had total attendance of 92 over the course of the year. We completed 364 suiting sessions during 2021, a 32% increase over 2020, and an indication that women are slowly but surely returning to the workforce.

Thanks to a very special funder, the Quinn Family Foundation, we introduced a scholarship program in 2021. We have a partnership with Academy for Nursing and Health Professions to help women become Patient Care Technicians, and we are partnering with Palm Beach State College to help women become nail and facial technicians.

Considering the pandemic, we opted not to hold our annual "Style for Hope" luncheon. In its place, we launched a direct mail campaign asking for donations equivalent to the purchase price of a ticket. As usual, our supportive community really came through, helping us to raise nearly \$30,000. We did hold our annual "Shop for Success" pop-up sale in 2021, at a brand-new venue: Rosemary Square. This location turned out to be quite beneficial for us, as we raised our highest amount ever for the annual event – over \$40,000!



Not a group to rest on their laurels, our team launched a few new initiatives during 2021 in addition to our "business as usual" efforts.

We are very excited to announce that in May we opened a second location for Dress for Success Palm Beaches in Belle Glade, a much under-served area of Palm Beach County where we felt our services could really be utilized. In the summer of 2021, we held a very special "Teacher Appreciation Week" to honor teachers in our community by offering them a new outfit as they started the new school year. We filled all 50 appointment slots that were available and received such favorable feedback that we know we will host a similar event in 2022.

Our hard work and determination have not gone unnoticed! In 2021, we were finalists for the Chamber of Commerce of the Palm Beaches Health and Human Services Organization of the Year, and we were recipients of the Nonprofits First "Hats Off" Award for Small Nonprofits!

We remain committed to and laser-focused on our mission of empowering women to achieve economic independence. We also remain committed to doing our part to ensure gender parity and racial equity. We believe that all persons deserve to be treated with dignity and respect and accept nothing less from our staff and volunteers. We believe our volunteers, whom we rely so heavily upon given our lean staff of three, are the backbone of our organization, and for their generosity of spirit we are eternally grateful.

We remain committed to being good stewards of all investments in our organization; we appreciate the faith and trust that our donors put into us.

We continue to move forward. Thank you for coming along with us.






2017-2021 Client Suitings







